STATION ROAD – ROAD CLOSURE UPDATE

Following Storm Eunice, Oxfordshire County Council issued an Emergency Temporary Traffic Regulation Notice relating to the need for an emergency road closure for Station Road, Brize Norton, to reduce the possibility of danger to highway users associated with the loose material from the RAF Brize Norton Hangar roof.

The duration of the closure was estimated to be for a period of 5 days until the building could be made safe. However, because of additions of Storm Franklin and Gladys, the notice has had to be extended.

Brize Norton Parish Council has been in touch with OCC again regarding the lack of road signage directing traffic away from Station Road by means of additional signage and diversion signs but also advising that access is available to residents and businesses.

Finally, we are now receiving updates and the latest is that the road closure will remain in place until at least Friday, 4th March when Engineers will re-assess the roof damage.

Even today, we have requested for more accurate and appropriate signage and that OCC attend the site as a matter of urgency.

We will continue to monitor the situation on behalf of the community.
