#### Artwork:

- Supply your own, to spec, by the artwork deadline or;

#### Payment:

- Payment to The Chapel Hill Group
  - This payment is removed from the total cost to Brize Norton Parish Council for production of newsletter
  - Payment <u>must</u> be made via BACS prior to print deadline. Pro-forma invoice with payment details will be supplied on booking
  - VAT is applicable to advertising cost
  - The hope is that the magazine can be self-financing. Any money left over will go into a community fund pot. The Parish Council will subsidise any shortfall
- Deadlines
  - May-August Issue
    - Advertising booking by 10<sup>th</sup> April 2025
    - Artwork/article deadline by 12<sup>th</sup> April 2025
    - Print deadline 19<sup>th</sup> April 2025
  - Summer/Autumn (delivered in the 1st week of September)
    - Advertising booking by 11<sup>th</sup> August 2025
    - Artwork/article deadline by 11<sup>th</sup> August 2025
    - Print/payment deadline 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2025
  - Winter Issue (delivered End of January)
    - Advertising booking by 5<sup>th</sup> December 2026
    - Artwork/article deadline by 5<sup>th</sup> December 2026
